

# Pricing and Options for 2012 Produce CSA

## 1. Regular Season

- \*Runs from mid-May through the end of October
- \*Receive a wide variety of produce from each growing season - spring, summer and fall
- \*A **full share** is picked up every Thursday
- \*A **bi-weekly half-share** is the same amount of produce as a full-share, but picked up every other Thursday.
- \*A **weekly half-share** is picked up every Tuesday with half the amount of produce as a full share each time.

## 2. Early Spring Share

- \*Runs from April 19-May 10
- \*Receive a weekly share of asparagus, bok choy, spinach, spring mix lettuce, radishes, spring onions, and possibly some potted herbs or farm fresh local eggs!
- \*Picked up every Thursday

## 3. Summer Share

- \*Runs from July 12-August 30
- \*Receive a wide variety of produce from our summer crops
- \*Picked up every Thursday

#### Regular Season Produce CSA

##### **\*Full-Share**

- \$495** register before Dec. 1, 2011 & receive a \$20 giftcard
- \$495** register between Dec. 2, 2011 & Apr. 1, 2012 no gift card
- \$515** register between April 2 & May 15, 2012

##### **\*Bi-Weekly Half-Share**

- \$275** register before Dec. 1, 2011
- \$290** register between Dec. 2, 2011 & Apr. 1, 2012
- \$300** register between April 2 & May 15, 2012

##### **\*Weekly Half-Share**

- \$300** register before Dec. 1, 2011
- \$315** register between Dec. 2, 2011 & Apr. 1, 2012
- \$325** register between Apr. 2 & May 15, 2012

#### Early Spring Share

- \$100** register before February 15, 2012
- \$115** register between February 16 and April 15, 2012

#### Summer Share

- \$200** register between Oct. 15, 2011 & Apr. 1, 2012
- \$225** register between Apr. 2 & May 15, 2012

# New Add-On Options for 2012

These options are an add-on to the produce CSA. You must purchase a share in the produce CSA in order to purchase any of the add-on's.

## 1. One Dozen Brown Free-Range Eggs

\* **\$84** register between Oct. 15, 2011 & May 15, 2012

\*Picked up weekly from May 15 to October 25

The eggs are raised by our trusted Amish friends and partners who have farms in southern Lancaster County. They are antibiotic- and hormone-free and guaranteed to be good. Once you've eaten their fresh eggs, you'll never go back to grocery store eggs again!

## 2. One Pound Loaf of All Natural Bread

\* **\$96** register between Oct. 15, 2011 & May 15, 2012

\* Picked up weekly from May 15 to October 25

The bread comes to us from American Hearth Bakery located on Wilso Avenue in Baltimore. It's baked fresh each day and delivered to us before sunrise each morning. This bread is made with all natural ingredients, no preservatives. It's packaged in one pound loaves and is pre-sliced for your convenience. You will have a choice of White, Whole Wheat, Honey Oat, Sunflower or Cinnamon Raisin. Each variety will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
